1 ABOUT NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

World AIDS Day

Date: 01 December 2025 | **Category:** Health

On the occasion of World AIDS Day, the NSS Cell of Sai Tirupati University organised a comprehensive awareness programme to educate students and the local community about HIV/AIDS — its causes, transmission, prevention, and the importance of destigmatising those living with the condition. The programme was held in the university campus with active participation of NSS volunteers, faculty members, and invited health professionals from the Udaipur district.

Key Objectives:

- ✦ To spread scientifically accurate awareness about HIV/AIDS transmission and prevention.
- ✦ To combat stigma and discrimination against PLHIV (People Living with HIV).
- ✦ To encourage voluntary HIV testing and early detection.
- ✦ To sensitise youth about responsible behaviour and safe practices.

Observation of Human Rights Day

Date: 10 December 2025 | Category: Social

The NSS Cell observed Human Rights Day on 10th December 2025, commemorating the adoption of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights by the United Nations General Assembly on 10th December 1948. The programme included a thought-provoking discussion on fundamental rights guaranteed under the Indian Constitution, the rights of marginalised communities, and the role of youth in upholding human dignity.

Key Objectives:

- To create awareness among students about Universal Human Rights and the Indian Constitution.
- To sensitise volunteers about the rights of underprivileged, tribal, and differently-abled persons.
- To encourage civic engagement and social responsibility among youth.

Outcomes & Impact:

- ✓ A panel discussion on contemporary human rights challenges in India was held.
- ✓ Essay writing competition on the theme 'Youth and Human Rights' organised.
- ✓ 120+ students participated; winners felicitated by the Programme Officer.

Voluntary Blood Donation Camp

A Voluntary Blood Donation Camp was jointly organised by the NSS Cell of Sai Tirupati University in collaboration with the Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences (PIMS), Udaipur. The camp aimed to address the perennial shortage of blood in the region, particularly during the winter months when donation rates typically decline. NSS volunteers played an active role in motivating their peers and community members to donate blood voluntarily.

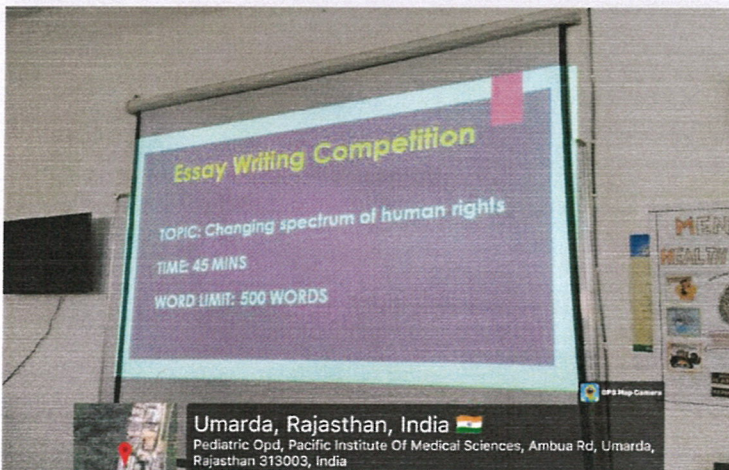
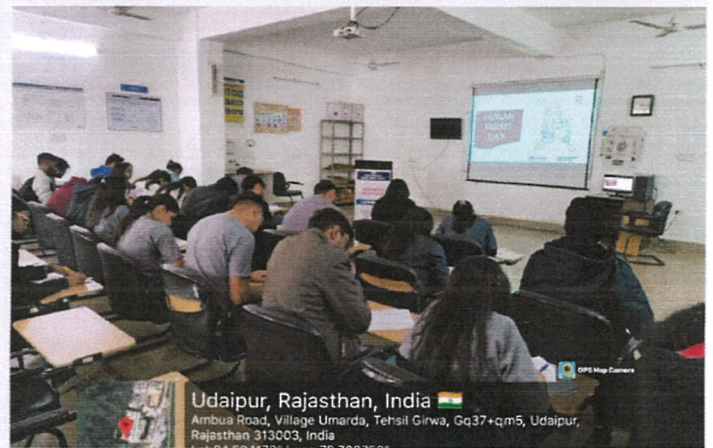
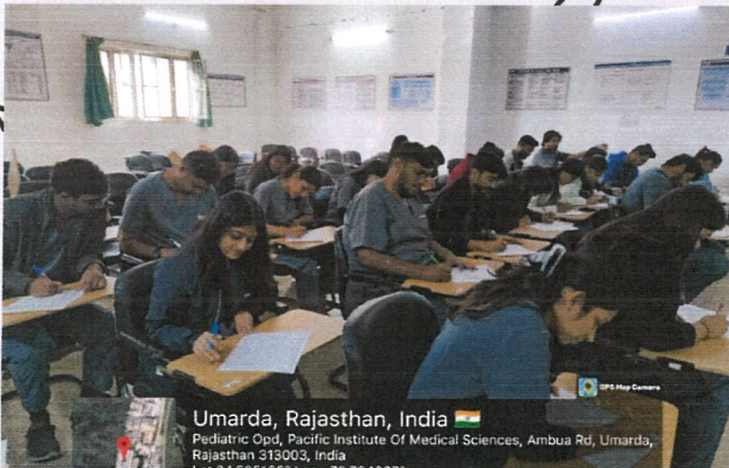
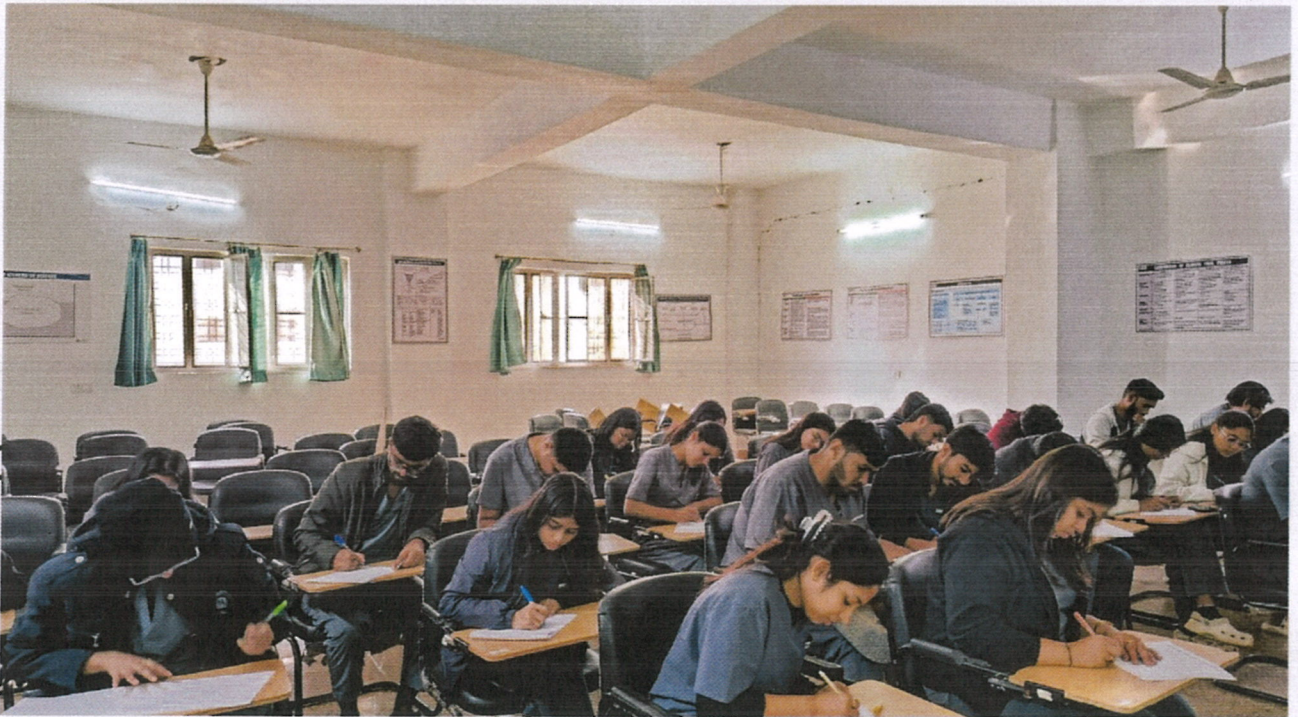
Key Objectives:

- ✓ Special lecture by a social activist on youth's role in nation-building attracted wide audience.

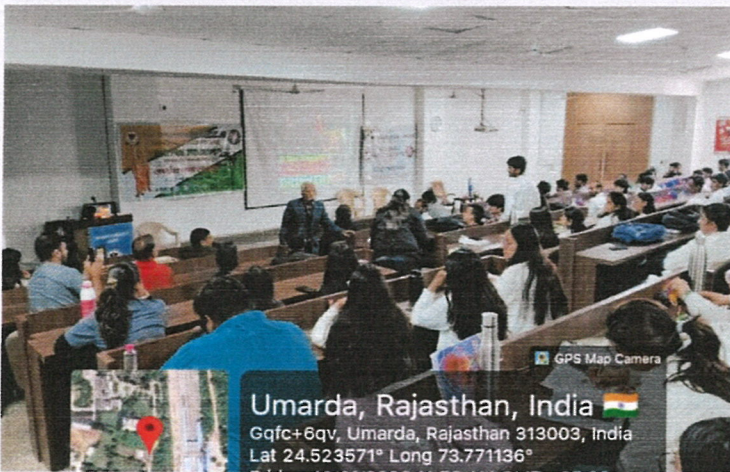

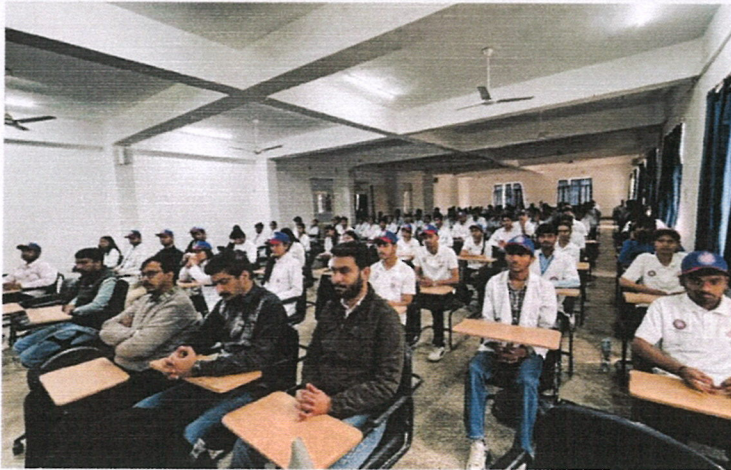

The NSS Cell concluded the academic year's events calendar with a vibrant observation of World Health Day on 7th April 2026. Aligned with the WHO's theme for 2026, the programme focused on holistic health — physical, mental, and social well-being — among youth. Activities included a health awareness walkathon, yoga session, a nutritional awareness workshop conducted by the PIMS Dietetics Department, and an expert talk on mental health.

Key Objectives:

- 🎯 To promote holistic health awareness — physical, mental, and social — among students.
- 🎯 To encourage healthy lifestyle practices, physical activity, and balanced nutrition.
- 🎯 To sensitise students about mental health and reduce stigma around seeking help.
- 🎯 To mark the founding of WHO and celebrate universal health goals.

Outcomes & Impact:

- ✓ A 3 km health walkathon conducted with 80+ participants, including faculty and students.
- ✓ Free health check-up camp with BMI measurement and blood pressure monitoring organised.

6 WAY FORWARD — NSS PLAN 2026–27

Building on the momentum of 2025–26, the NSS Cell of Sai Tirupati University has charted an ambitious plan for 2026–27, aligned with the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports' national priorities and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

1. **Special Camp:** Organisation of a 7-day NSS Special Camp in an adopted village near Udaipur — focusing on sanitation, digital literacy, and health awareness.
2. **NSS Volunteer Strength Enhancement:** Target of 150 volunteers from all constituent colleges.
3. **Environment Conservation Drive:** Tree plantation campaign under 'Ek Ped Maa ke Naam' initiative.
4. **Digital Literacy Mission:** Conduct digital literacy workshops in 5 government schools in Umarda and surrounding areas.
5. **Collaboration with Local Administration:** Formalise MoUs with the Udaipur District Collectorate, PIMS, and leading NGOs for structured community engagement.
6. **NSS Volunteer Training Camp:** Annual volunteer training for leadership development and social entrepreneurship.
7. **Documentation and Recognition:** Systematic documentation of all activities for submission to the Regional NSS Centre and NAAC.

7 CONCLUSION

The academic year 2025–26 has been a year of meaningful action, community engagement, and youth leadership for the NSS Cell of Sai Tirupati University.
