1. Introduction

A voluntary blood donation camp was organized at PIMS, Umarda by the Blood Bank. The camp aimed to promote voluntary blood donation as a safe, ethical, and life-saving practice and to strengthen community participation in healthcare. Such initiatives play a crucial role in inculcating social responsibility, empathy, and a spirit of selfless service among NSS volunteers. By actively participating in awareness generation and donor mobilization, the volunteers gained valuable insight into the importance of voluntary blood donation in saving lives and supporting the healthcare system, in accordance with the NSS motto, "Not Me, But You."

2. Objectives

- To sensitize NSS volunteers about the importance of voluntary blood donation
- To create awareness regarding the need for safe and regular blood donation
- To dispel myths and misconceptions related to blood donation
- To motivate students, patient attendants, and hospital visitors to voluntarily donate blood
- To promote altruism, ethical values, and social responsibility
- To encourage NSS volunteers to become responsible healthcare professionals in the future

3. Event Highlights

- NSS volunteers were sensitized by the Program Officer, Dr. Avantika Gupta regarding the importance of voluntary blood donation a week before the camp. Volunteers were given defined roles and responsibilities for the successful organization of the camp. Technical supervisor of Blood Bank and faculty from Pathology Department also briefed them regarding eligibility criteria, donor safety, and post-donation care. Emphasis was laid on the role of youth in ensuring an adequate and safe blood supply.
- The volunteers actively motivated fellow students, patient attendants, and hospital visitors to participate in the blood donation camp. Through interpersonal communication and awareness messages, they addressed common fears and misconceptions related to blood donation and encouraged first-time donors.
- A total of 64 donors, including NSS volunteers, other motivated students, interns and patient attendants came forward for voluntary blood donation. A brief medical history was taken prior to donation, followed by measurement of weight, hemoglobin estimation, and blood group determination to ensure donor safety and eligibility.
- NSS volunteers assisted the Blood Bank staff in various activities including donor guidance, registration support, pre-donation screening, and post-donation care. Volunteers also ensured proper rest and refreshments for donors after donation, thereby facilitating smooth conduct of the camp.




- v. Certificates of appreciation were distributed to all donors in recognition of their noble contribution, which served as motivation for continued voluntary participation in blood donation activities.

4. Key Outcomes

- Improved awareness and positive attitude towards voluntary blood donation among NSS volunteers
- Active participation of students and patient attendants as voluntary blood donors
- Strengthened understanding of donor safety and blood bank procedures
- Development of communication, coordination, and leadership skills among NSS volunteers
- Reinforcement of humanitarian values and ethical responsibility

5. Conclusion

The blood donation camp was successfully conducted with enthusiastic participation of NSS volunteers. The camp not only contributed to strengthening blood bank reserves but also provided meaningful learning experiences for the volunteers. By engaging in donor sensitization, mobilization, and assistance, the NSS volunteers exemplified the spirit of service and social responsibility, truly reflecting the ethos of the National Service Scheme.

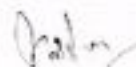

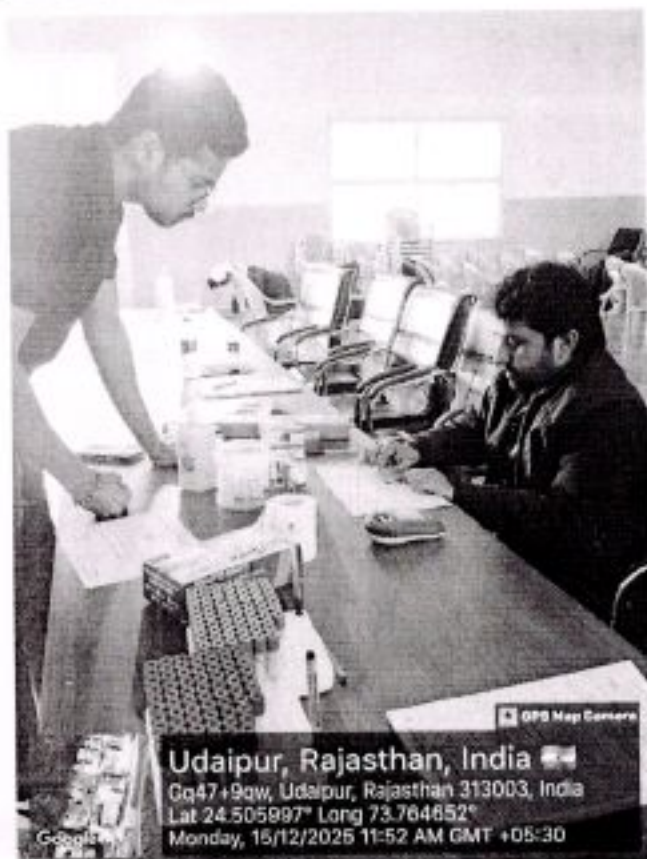

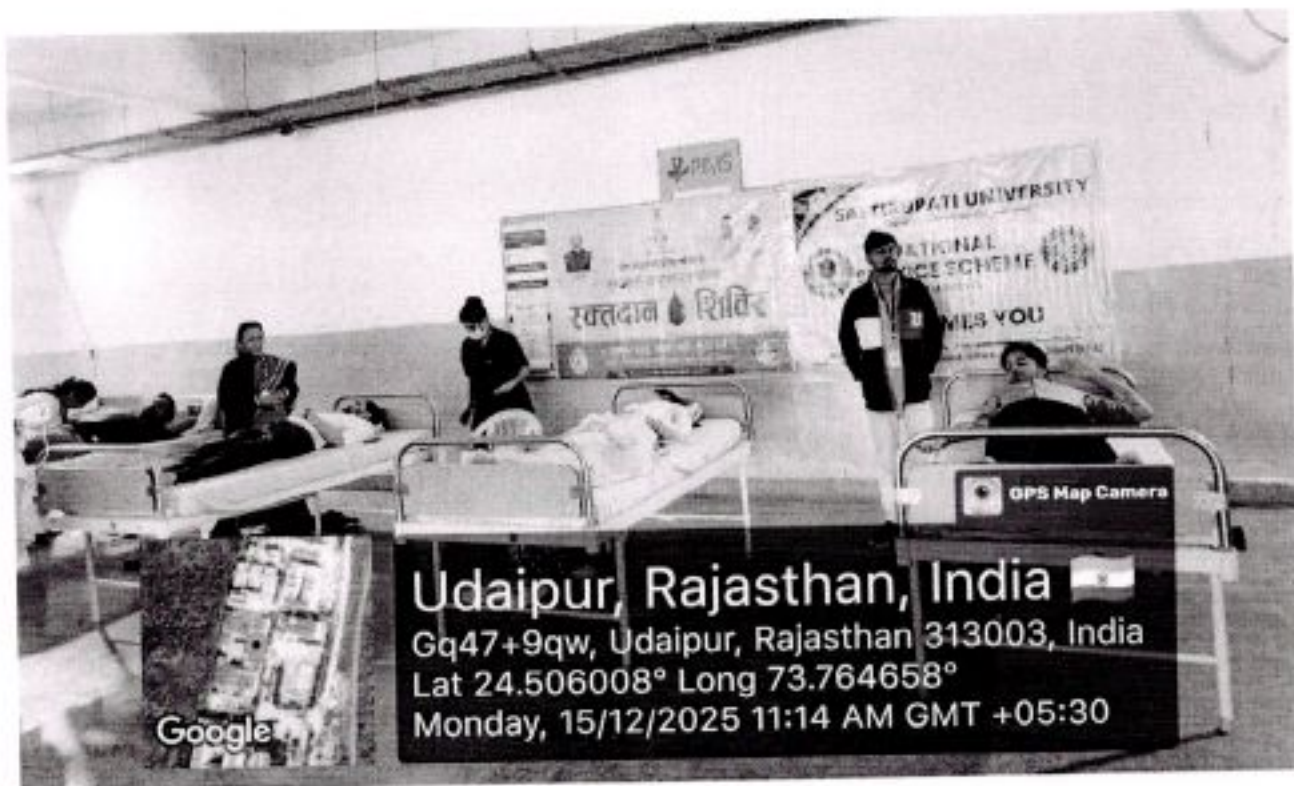

Registration and pre-donation assessment:





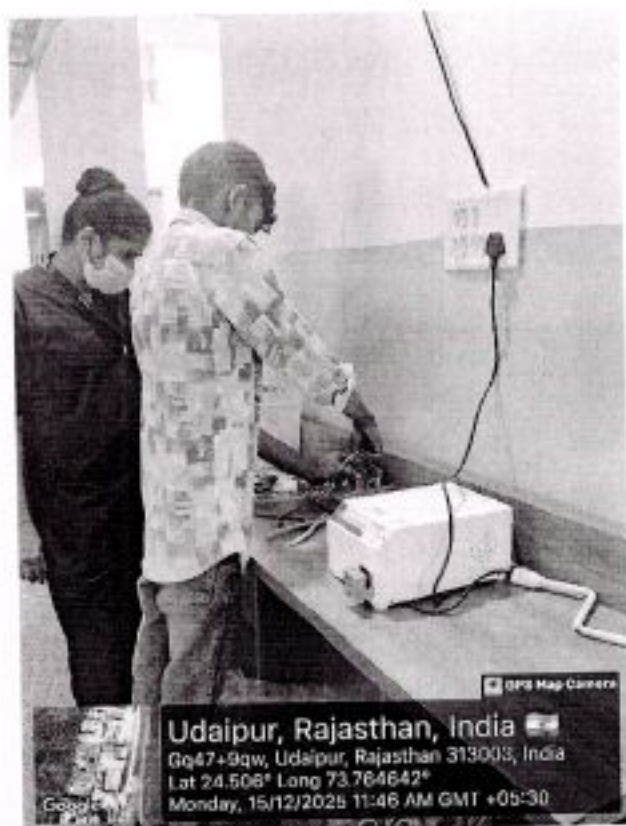


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Post-donation Processing of Blood Bags:
