SUMMARY

The Republic Day of India, celebrated annually on January 26th, commemorates the adoption of the Indian Constitution in 1950. 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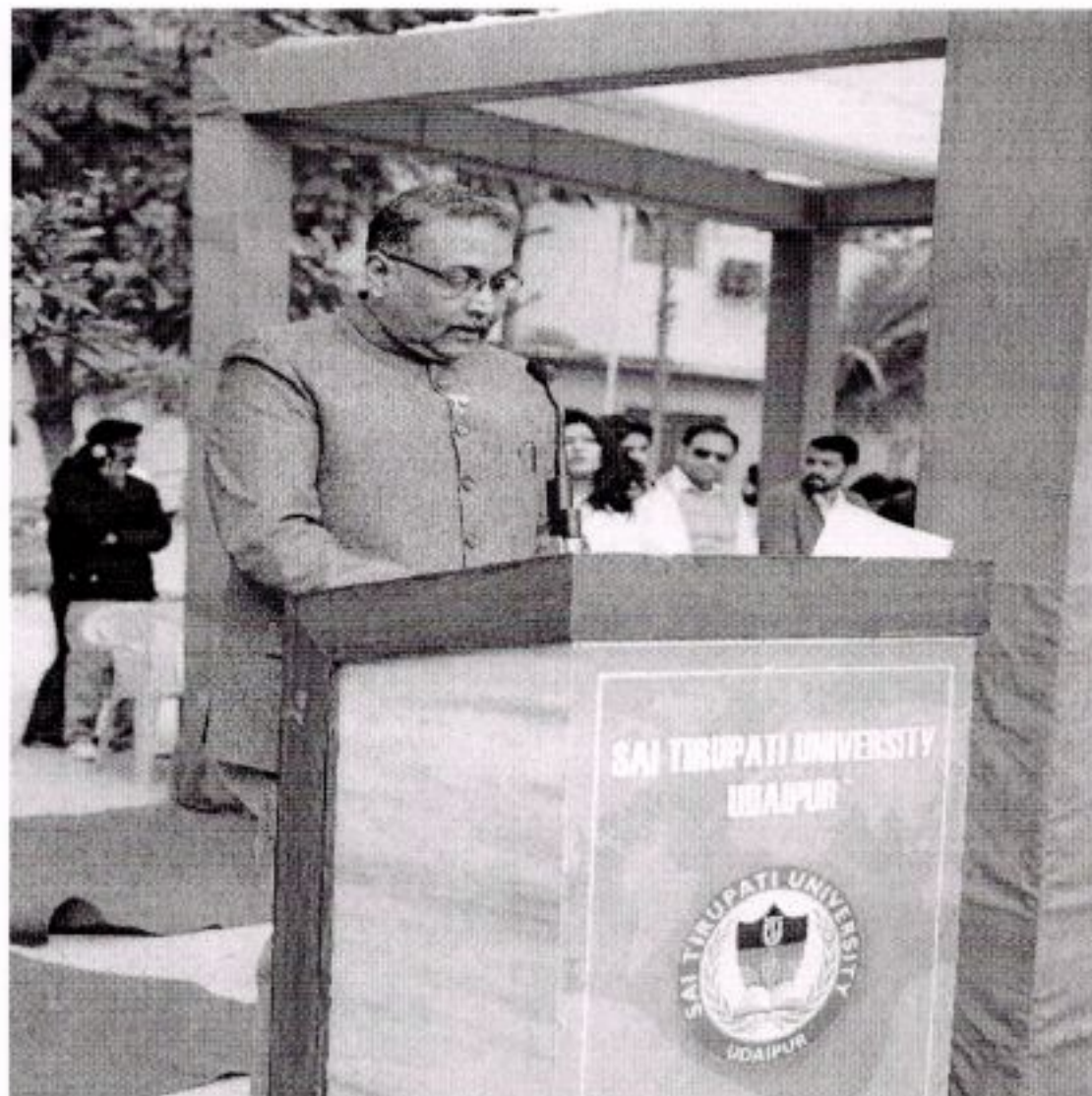
This segment symbolized the constitutional foundation of the Indian nation and the institution's allegiance to democratic values.

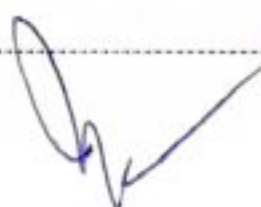

 - Contribution to regional and national healthcare infrastructure development

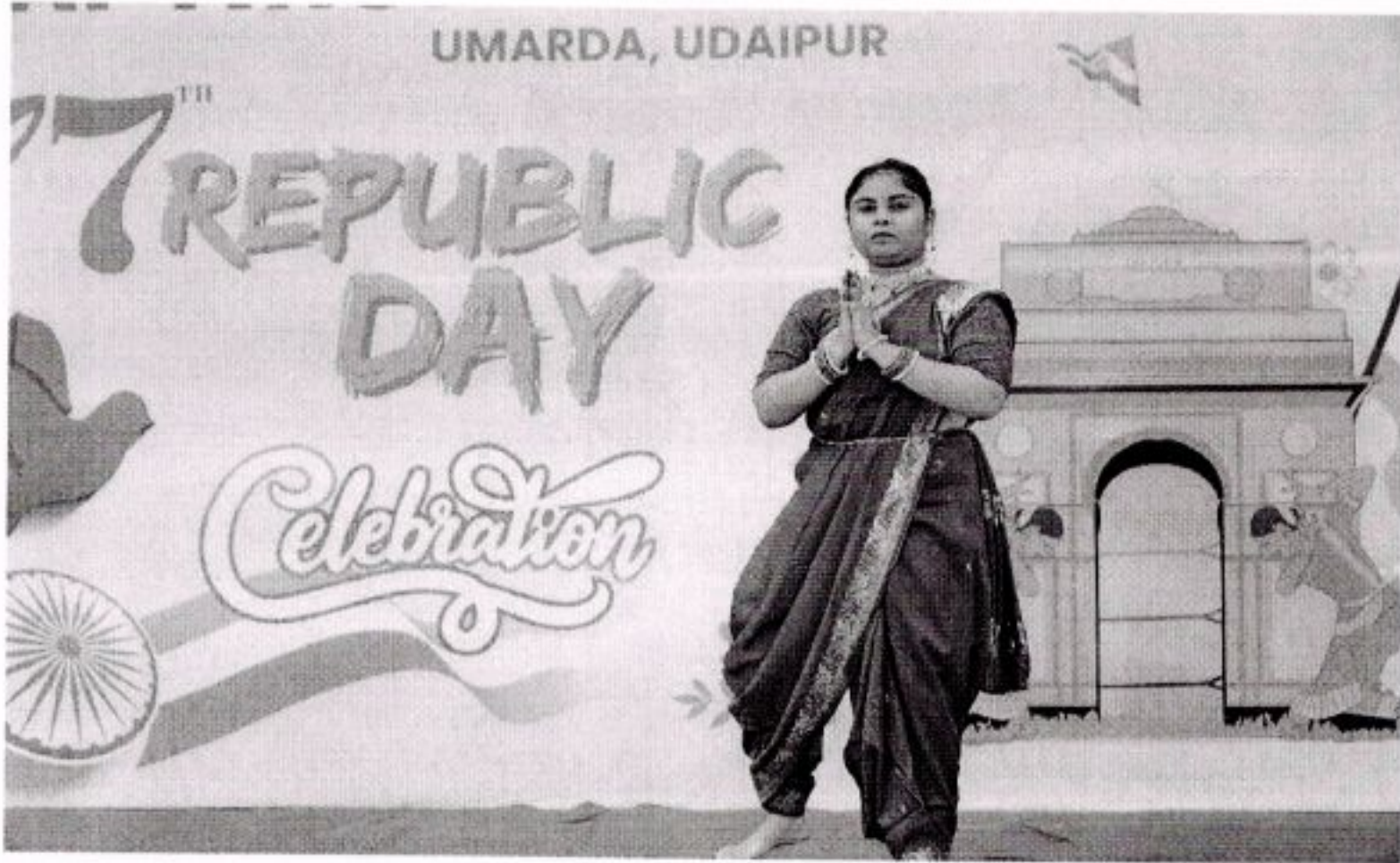
These addresses bridged institutional healthcare achievements with national development, illustrating how medical excellence serves nation-building goals.
