1. Introduction

On 10th December 2025, Human Rights Day was observed by the Department of Community Medicine, PIMS Umarda, in alignment with the global theme "Human Rights, Our Everyday Essentials." The program aimed to sensitize students to the evolving dimensions of human rights and their relevance in everyday life and healthcare practice.

In a time marked by uncertainty and social challenges, the theme of Human Rights Day underscores the continued relevance of human rights as fundamental to human dignity and well-being. The campaign aims to reconnect individuals with human rights by highlighting their presence in everyday life, reinforcing that these rights are essential, practical, and achievable, and encouraging greater awareness and collective responsibility.

The competition provided a platform for students to express their understanding and perspectives on emerging human rights issues in contemporary society. Sixty-nine participants brought into light contemporary affairs like ongoing wars, COVID crises, etc and gave us solutions through their lenses. Certificates were awarded to the first prize and runner-up winners by the Principal and the Head of the Department in recognition of their thoughtful insights.

This was followed by an awareness session, where faculty members from the Department of Community Medicine highlighted the significance of human rights in healthcare, ethical medical practice, and community well-being. Key discussions focused on access to healthcare, dignity, equity, gender rights, and the responsibility of medical professionals in safeguarding human rights. The interactive session encouraged student participation and discussion, fostering a deeper understanding of the theme.

- Improved understanding of the evolving nature of human rights and their relevance to public health.
- Active student engagement through academic and participatory learning activities.
