► Duration of the Course

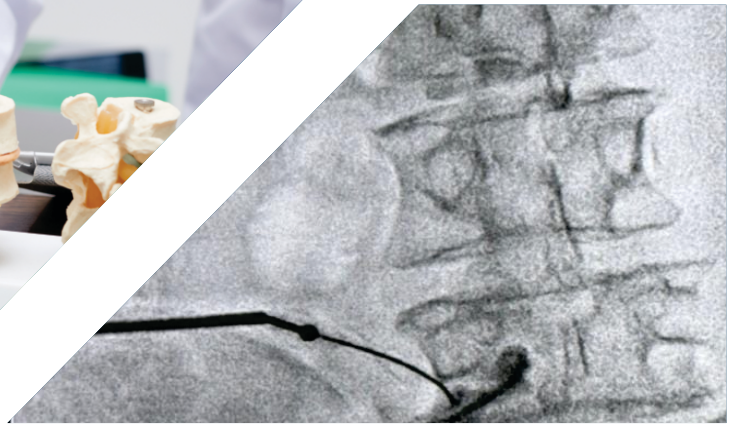
3 month and 12 months (Full-time)
