1. Introduction

Venkateshwar Institute of Pharmacy organized a Blood Donation Camp on 24th January 2025 in collaboration with the Rajasthan Chemist Alliance at the Blood Bank, Pacific Institute of Medical Sciences (PIMS), Umarda, Udaipur. The programme was conceptualized with the primary objective of contributing to community healthcare support through voluntary blood donation and addressing the continuous demand for safe blood in emergency and critical medical situations.

Blood donation remains one of the most significant and life-saving contributions to society, particularly in cases of surgeries, trauma care, maternal health, and chronic illnesses. Recognizing this vital need, the institute undertook this initiative to not only facilitate blood collection but also to create awareness among students and the local community about the importance of regular, voluntary, and safe blood donation practices.

The initiative was aligned with the institution's broader vision of promoting social responsibility, civic consciousness, and humanitarian values among students and staff. It also aimed to provide experiential exposure to students by engaging them in real-world healthcare support activities. Through awareness sessions, structured participation, and medical supervision, the camp successfully fostered a spirit of service, empathy, and community engagement, reinforcing the role of educational institutions in supporting public health initiatives.

2. Objectives

- To contribute to the blood bank by collecting blood units for patients in need
- To promote awareness about voluntary and safe blood donation
- To encourage participation of students and staff in community service activities
- To instil a sense of social responsibility and healthcare awareness

3. Event Highlights

The Blood Donation Camp achieved its intended objectives with the following measurable outcomes:

- A total of 15 units of blood were successfully collected and contributed to the hospital blood bank, directly supporting patient care needs.

- The programme enhanced awareness regarding voluntary blood donation, its safety, and its importance in emergency healthcare services.
- Students demonstrated increased social responsibility, empathy, and civic engagement, aligning with institutional values of community service.

4. Outcomes

- The camp was conducted from 08:00 AM to 04:00 PM at the Blood Bank, PIMS Hospital.
- Pre-donation screening and medical supervision were ensured to maintain safety standards.
- 12 students and 3 faculty members actively donated blood, while additional participation from local community members was also observed.
- Awareness sessions and pamphlet distribution were conducted to educate participants on:
 - Benefits of blood donation
 - Eligibility criteria and safety measures
 - Importance of regular voluntary donation
- Post-donation care, including refreshments and observation, was provided to all donors.
- The event was supported by proper planning, circular dissemination, and structured donor eligibility criteria (age, haemoglobin, weight), ensuring systematic execution.

5. Conclusion

The Blood Donation Camp organized by Venkateshwar Institute of Pharmacy was a successful and socially impactful initiative, effectively fulfilling its objectives of supporting healthcare services and promoting voluntary blood donation awareness. The collection of 13 units of blood, along with active participation from students, faculty, and community members, reflects the effectiveness of the programme in addressing real healthcare needs.

The event reinforced the importance of voluntary blood donation as a life-saving practice and highlighted the role of educational institutions in mobilizing youth participation for public welfare. 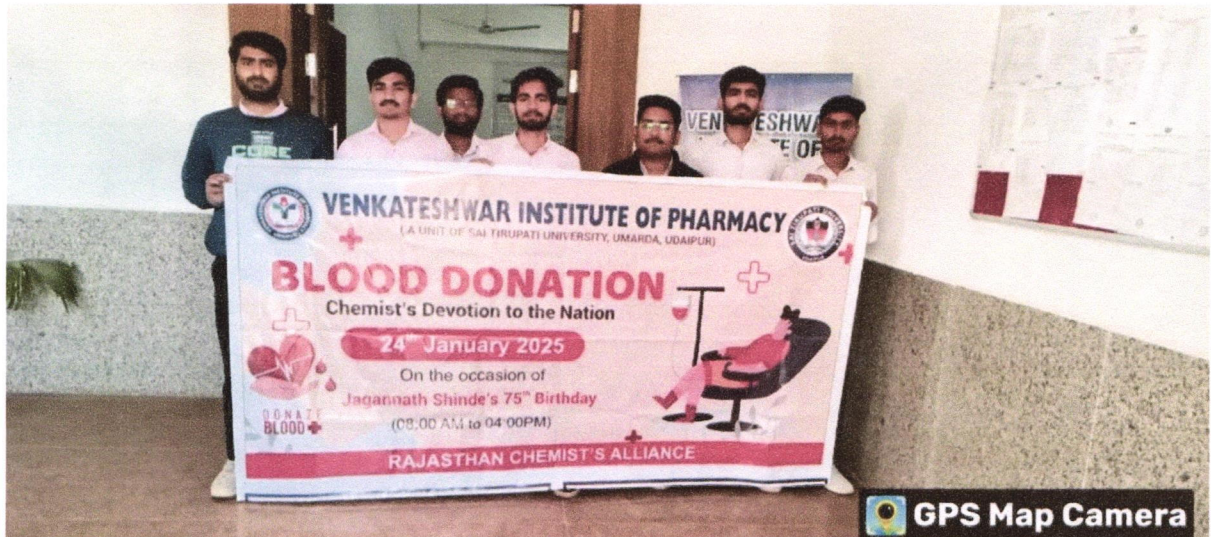
