Diagnostic Services Provided:

- Complete Blood Count (CBC)
- Haemoglobin Estimation (Hb%)
- Fasting Blood Sugar (FBS)
- Basic health screening and symptom-based guidance
- Referral advice for further consultation where required

Operational Highlights:

- Proper protocols for sample collection, handling, hygiene, and testing were strictly followed.
- Participants were counselled regarding nutrition, hygiene, diabetes prevention, and regular health check-ups.
- Students assisted in registration, patient interaction, sample collection, testing procedures, and report coordination under supervision.

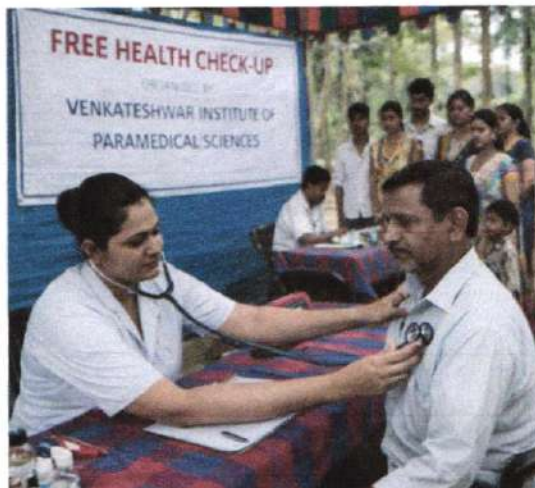
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
