1. Introduction

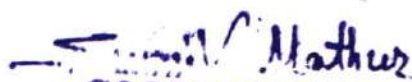

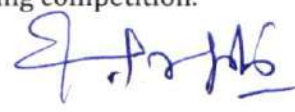

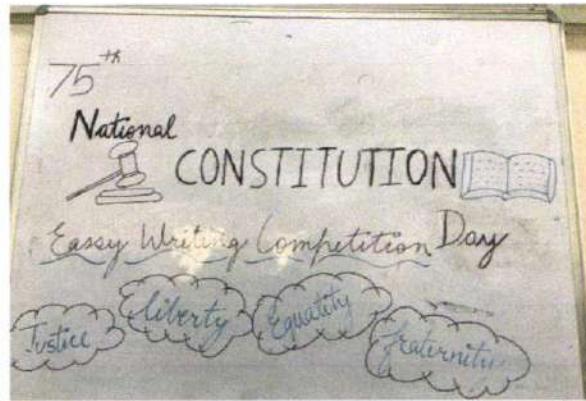
