1. Introduction

Venkateshwar Institute of Pharmacy organized an *educational visit to the Medicinal and Herbal Garden at Van Anusandhan Farm, Sisarma on 27th October 2023* as part of its experiential learning initiative for pharmacy students. The programme was designed to enhance students' practical understanding of medicinal plants, their therapeutic significance, and their applications in pharmaceutical sciences, particularly in the domain of pharmacognosy.

Medicinal plants form the foundation of both traditional and modern healthcare systems, serving as primary sources of numerous therapeutic agents. In the context of pharmacy education, it is essential for students to gain first-hand exposure to plant identification, classification, and medicinal uses, which cannot be fully achieved through classroom teaching alone.

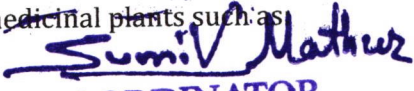
The visit aimed to bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and field-based learning by providing direct interaction with plant species and subject experts.

2. Objectives

- To provide practical exposure to medicinal and herbal plant species
- To enhance understanding of pharmacognosy and natural drug sources
- To develop skills in plant identification and classification
- To create awareness about conservation of medicinal plants
- To understand traditional and modern applications of herbal medicines
- To promote experiential learning beyond classroom teaching

3. Event Highlights

- The visit was attended by 105 participants, including students and faculty members, indicating strong academic engagement.
- The programme began with an introduction to the medicinal garden, highlighting its importance in healthcare, research, and conservation.
- Mr. Lalit Paliwal (Herbal Expert) conducted a detailed demonstration covering:
 - Identification and classification of medicinal plants
 - Therapeutic uses and pharmaceutical relevance of herbs
 - Cultivation and conservation practices
- Students were introduced to important medicinal plants such as:
 - Jyotishmati (Malkangani)
 - Vasa
 - Gurmur

- A hands-on learning approach was adopted, where students directly observed plant morphology and identification characteristics.
- An awareness session on conservation of rare medicinal species was conducted, emphasizing sustainable use of natural resources.
- The visit concluded with an interactive discussion, allowing students to clarify doubts and deepen their understanding.

4. Outcomes

The educational visit successfully achieved its objectives by significantly enhancing students' practical knowledge and understanding of medicinal and herbal plants. Participants developed improved skills in plant identification, classification, and recognition of key morphological features, which are essential competencies in pharmacognosy.

One of the key outcomes was the strengthening of conceptual clarity regarding natural drug sources and their pharmaceutical applications. Students were able to connect theoretical knowledge with real-world observations, thereby improving retention and understanding.

The exposure to various medicinal plants and expert demonstrations also increased awareness regarding the therapeutic significance of herbal medicines and their role in modern healthcare systems. Additionally, the session on conservation contributed to developing environmental awareness and responsibility toward sustainable use of medicinal resources.

The programme also fostered student engagement, curiosity, and analytical thinking, as participants actively interacted with the expert and explored the garden environment.

5. Conclusion

The educational visit to the Medicinal and Herbal Garden at Van Anusandhan Farm was successfully conducted and effectively fulfilled its objective of providing practical exposure to medicinal plants and their pharmaceutical relevance.

The programme demonstrated that field-based learning plays a crucial role in strengthening academic understanding, skill development, and professional competence among pharmacy students. The direct interaction with plant species and expert guidance ensured meaningful and application-oriented learning.

The active participation of students and faculty highlights the effectiveness of the initiative in promoting experiential learning and academic engagement. It also reinforced the importance of integrating classroom teaching with practical exposure in pharmacy education.

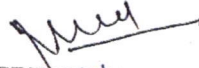
