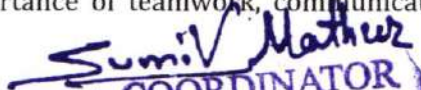

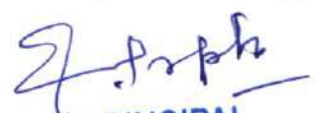

3. Event Highlights

- The first session on Basic Life Support System was conducted by Mr. Rajesh Choubisa, Vice-Principal, VIPS, from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM.
- The BLS session included demonstrations on:
 - Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
 - Airway management
 - Recovery position techniques
 - Primary patient assessment
 - Emergency response sequence
- A tea break from 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM provided an opportunity for interaction between faculty and students.
- The second session, led by Ms. Vaidika Rathore, focused on Emergency Drugs, covering:
 - Common emergency medications
 - Indications and contraindications
 - Dosage and administration routes
 - Safe handling practices
- Live demonstrations, case-based explanations, and interactive Q&A sessions made the workshop highly engaging and practical.
- Event Coordinators Ms. Anjali Sen and Mr. Yash Jain ensured smooth execution and active participation throughout the programme.

4. Outcomes

The workshop yielded highly positive learning outcomes and significantly enhanced students' preparedness for emergency situations. A total of **70 students** actively participated and benefited from the hands-on training sessions. Participants developed a clearer understanding of Basic Life Support protocols, CPR techniques, and emergency response systems.

The emergency drug session expanded their knowledge regarding essential medications, their dosage, administration methods, and safety considerations.

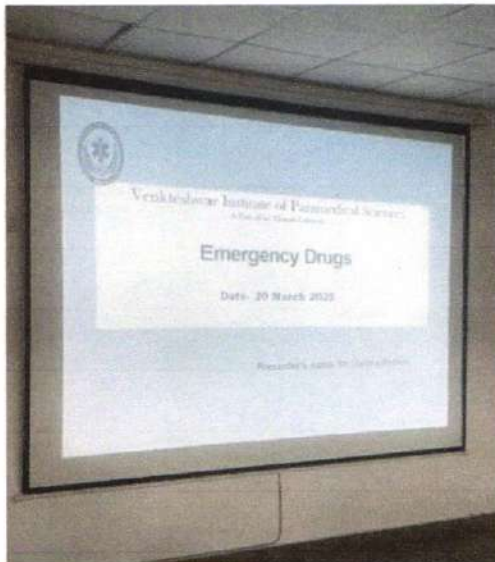
